CONTOUR SHEET™ PLASTER NT6168



INSTRUCTIONS

IMPORTANT: Prepare using a clean bowl and utensils. Do not clean utensils in sink or pour excess plaster down drain.

Working Time: 20 minutes

Mixing ratio (approximately): 2.5-parts plaster to 1-part water (by volume)

1. Pour Contour Sheet Plaster slowly into cold water. Let stand for 2 minutes, then stir thoroughly for 1-2 minutes. As a starting point, mix 8 oz plaster with 3 oz water to cover an area approximately 12" wide x 12" long x 1/8" deep.

TIP! Mix the plaster for a consistency that is appropriate to the application. Adjust plaster to water ratio for a thicker or thinner consistency. More water yields a thinner mixture.

Mix a thinner consistency when:

- the plaster needs to be spread easily, such as when covering large areas (that are not weight bearing) OR when there are a lot of crevices

Mix a thicker consistency when:

- applying to vertical surfaces so that the plaster doesn't run and pool
- an area of the Contour Sheet will bear weight (thicker mixtures yield stronger surfaces)
- there is a weak point due to shape, such as a 90° angle, or a seam

2. Mist Contour Sheet (NT6154-NT6159) or plaster surface with water, then pour or brush on plaster mixture.
3. Let dry 24 hours before coloring with Terrain Base Colors (NT6185-NT6186) or Rock Color System Pigments (NT6177-NT6184).

Times are approximate and may vary due to environmental conditions.



CAUTION: We do not recommend using Contour Sheet Plaster for body casts, as it may irritate skin and develop heat sufficient enough to cause burns. Do not take internally. Do not pour excess down drain. Discard in trash.



CARE INFORMATION: Clean up spills immediately with warm, soapy water. Should product dry on clothing or work surface, rub with a soft, dry brush before cleaning.
